




GA!: That's a mighty cute little fellow on the cover...



Jim: Thank you! That's Max, our son who is four. He's quite a ham, who loves to play with my tape measure. So, if you want to know how wide a box of cereal is; just ask

Max. He loves to play sports and go fishing. He says when he gets bigger he wants to work with me and already has several sets of his own tools. My wife, Vicki is my best

friend and we have been married for seven years this December. I am so thankful for her. I could have never been successful without her support. We are so blessed to have Max, who is our only child. We live in Belmont and love the warmth and sense of community you will find there.

GA!: So you are a local guy- did you go to school here?

GA! I'm thinking of having some work done, what are some important things to consider when hiring a contractor like yourself?

Jim: I enjoy being a Dad more than anything, so soccer games and fishing are big. Max caught a huge bass this year and his face said it all. Before the storms I used to play golf. My wife and I like to ride motorcycles. We enjoy going to Key West and hanging out with our friends and family.





The debate on the over-commercialization of Christmas seems to come each and every year. And yet, Christmas music is such an integral part of the season. It sets the mood.

After all, what is Christmas without Bing Crosby, Johnny Mathis, and Nat King Cole. Those guys (and many others) recorded iconic songs that are synomous with the season.

But what about Halloween? Where are the iconic Halloween songs?

Perhaps we feel Christmas, whereas we experience Halloween. Halloween has a more visual component to it. This seems to be true with all of the scary movies on TV and in movie theaters during that time of the year.

But that doesn't stop the members of the Asheville based-band, The Mad Tea (formerly Mad Tea Party).

The Mad Tea consists of Ami Worthen (ukulele, vocals) and Jason Kreckel (quitar, drums, vocals). For over ten years, this garage-pop duo has been rocking' out audiences all over and is a frequent opener for another North Carolina-based band, Southern Culture on the Skids.

Now, first things first. This band is all about the music – not politics. In fact, that is why they have had to change their name to The Mad Tea. According to their website, they are trying to "get away from the darn political associations and get back to the business of rock 'n roll".

Unfortunately, the Google goes with what's popular – and in the last few years, the conservative Tea Party movement has continued to trend.

Even though they share a similar name, they are completely different. Especially the way the band treats their music. Their mission is to rock out and have fun.



You won't find political commentary on their website. You will find, however, their latest Halloween/spooky musical contribution, "Batratspidercrab". And it's yours free to download.

This marks the third year in a row that Ami Worthen and Jason Kreckel have put together a Halloween-inspired project. In 2009, they released Zombie Boogie - a four-song EP featuring two originals and two obscure covers.

It was so well-received, they did it again the next year releasing another four songs entitled Rock n' Roll Ghoul.

They are back at it again, yet a bit scaled back releasing just one song this year. However, it for Halloween lovers everywhere to download for free.

Is it a Trick, or Treat? What's that you say; you don't like eggplant? Maybe you haven't tried it the right way yet, or maybe it's the way it looks when served or possibly the consistency. I say try it again, but this time let's make them more like twice baked potatoes. Mmmmm, you're thinking-I like twice baked potatoes, but the calories! Not to worry- these are healthy!

This interesting vegetable originates from India and is a part of the Nightshade family so it's related to tomato, potato and even tobacco. It actually contains the highest concentration of Nicotine of any plant, but don't worry! You would have to eat 20 pounds of eggplant to get the nicotine of one cigarette. In addition, the eggplant contains folic acid and potassium and helps to block the formation of free radicals. (Those pesky molecules associated with aging and a slew of diseases from Cancer to Cataracts)

Ingredients:

4 Eggplants – Recommend small ones that fit into your palm like a baking potato

1 Tsp of garlic


1 egg

Preparation:

Pre heat your oven to 350 degrees. Lightly pierce the eggplant and place them on a baking sheet. (good safety tip, I actually had one explode while creating this recipe) Bake the eggplant for 40 min or until they start to shrivel. Let cool and slice in half, clean the eggplant flesh from the outer skin gently with a spoon. This recipe only makes six so if you tear a couple of the skins you will still have enough. Place the baked eggplant flesh, red pepper, Ricotta, Parmesan, garlic and egg in a bowl and mix well, season with salt and pepper to taste. Carefully fill six skins with this mixture, sprinkle with bread crumbs and a bit more Parmesan, Place back in the oven and bake for 30 minutes more, serve hot. If desired a bit of butter can be served on top, but our taste testers found it was not needed. Serve this treat at your next dinner and you will find that it is a nice little trick on your tastebuds.
